**Investigation Into a Student Missing From a  
Special Education School in Brooklyn**

**Report Released Today**

Today, Special Commissioner of Investigation Richard J. Condon released a report detailing an investigation concerning a 15-year-old female Special Needs student who walked out of P 371 in Brooklyn, on September 15, 2014, and was missing for three days. The investigation discovered that three other students also walked out of the school that day.

Special Commissioner Condon referred his findings to Chancellor Fariña. No misconduct was found and no disciplinary action was recommended against any DOE employee.

The Office of the Special Commissioner of Investigation is part of the New York City Department of Investigation and Special Commissioner Condon reports to Commissioner Mark G. Peters.
